What is this type of insurance?

This is a travel insurance policy.



What is insured?

We offer Single Trip and Annual Multi-trip policy options through our Super Duper level of cover.

The policy covers up to the following, if:

✓ You are not able to go on your trip	£5,000
✓ Your departure is delayed by 12 hours or more	£240
✓ You miss your departure from the UK	£1,500
✓ You choose to cancel after a delay of 12 hours	£5,000
✓ You need emergency medical treatment	£10,000,000
✓ You are confined to a public hospital	£1,500
✓ You need to come home early	£5,000
✓ Your aftercare, following hospitalisation abroad:	
- home help	£500
- cosmetic surgery	£3,000
- dental treatment	£300
- physiotherapy	£750
✓ Your convalescence in the UK, following hospitalisation abroad for 5 days or more	£750
✓ Your possessions, medical aids or prescribed medications are delayed	£250
✓ Your possessions are lost, stolen or damaged	£3,000
✓ Your medical aids are lost, stolen or damaged	£2,000
✓ Your prescribed medication is lost, stolen or damaged	£500
✓ Your cash is lost or stolen	£500
✓ Your passport is lost or stolen	£400
✓ You are mugged	£250
✓ You are hijacked or kidnapped	£2,500
✓ Your trip is disrupted by a catastrophe	£750
✓ You are held legally liable for injury or damage	£2,000,000
✓ You need legal advice	£50,000
✓ You suffer death or injury following an accident	£20,000
✓ Your journey is disrupted including airspace closure	£3,000
✓ Your scheduled airline becomes insolvent	£2,500

What is not insured?

- ✗ Excesses apply on the Super Duper policy and are shown in the Insurance Policy - you are responsible for paying this amount in the event of a claim.
- ✗ Existing medical conditions that you haven't told us about or where we've not agreed to cover them in writing.
- ✗ Dental treatment other than to alleviate sudden pain.
- ✗ Trips which have begun before your policy cover start date.
- ✗ Events or situations you know about before taking out a policy or booking a trip which could mean you can't travel.
- ✗ You taking part in activities unless stated as covered on your Policy Schedule.
- ✗ Claims caused by alcohol, drugs or substance abuse.
- ✗ Trips longer than 45 days on a Super Duper Annual Multi-trip policy.
- ✗ Natural damage (e.g. wear & tear or from weather).



Are there any restrictions on cover?

- ! There is no cover for trips booked or travel to a destination outside the area of cover shown on your policy schedule.
- ! Unless agreed with us there will be no cover if the FCO advise against travel to your destination.
- ! There is no cover at the start of the policy if anyone to be insured is waiting to have any medical investigation, or the results of any test or investigations, unless these relate to an already diagnosed condition you've told us about.
- ! There is no cover to cancel or cut short a trip because of any follow up appointment or surgery that relates to investigations or tests that are known about when a trip is booked.
- ! There is no cover for valuables or money unless with you, in a safe/safety deposit box or locked in your accommodation.



Where am I covered?

IMPORTANT: this will depend on your needs - the cover you chose is shown on your Policy Schedule.

- Australia and New Zealand
- Europe 2
- Europe 1
- United Kingdom



What are my obligations?

- At the start of the policy you must give complete and accurate answers to any questions we may ask you.
- Premiums must be paid on time.
- If you need to make a claim you must provide us with a fully completed claim form as soon as possible.
- If you need medical assistance while abroad, you must call us before going to a medical facility (other than a pharmacy), or as soon as you possibly can thereafter.
- You must let us know of any changes including any changes to medical conditions or the health of anyone on the policy.



When and how do I pay?

You must pay your premium before the policy can be issued.

When does the cover start and end?

Annual Multi-trip travel insurance, covers a period of one year.

Single Trip travel insurance covers the period from the date on which you pay your premium until the return date shown in your Policy Schedule.



How do I cancel the Contract?

You have a 'cooling off' period where, should you decide that you find that the terms and conditions do not meet your requirements and provided you have not travelled or claimed on the policy. You can do this by calling Free Spirit on **02392 419 080** within 14 days of purchase to obtain a full refund of the premium paid.

Should you wish to cancel your policy outside of the 14 day cooling off period, provided you have not made a claim on the policy (irrespective of whether your claim was successful or not) and you confirm in writing that there is no claim pending, we will refund 5% of the total premium paid on your Annual Multi-trip policy, for each full calendar month remaining on the policy from the date of cancellation, or for Single Trip policies we will refund 50% of the policy premium and any additional premium applied to your existing medical conditions.
